

# LANDSCAPE PAINTING WORKSHOP IN EGYPT WITH WALT BARTMAN - 12 DAYS



## DAY 1/2: CAIRO

Arrive at Cairo airport where you will be met by your Tour Manager and escorted to your hotel for check-in. Included dinner and overnight in Cairo.

## DAY 3: CAIRO

Day trip to visit one of the Great Pyramids and the Sphinx of Giza. Afternoon painting in the area with Walt Bartman.

## DAY 4: CAIRO

Morning guided tour of Memphis/Sakkara. Memphis was the ancient capital of Lower Egypt for many consecutive dynasties. Memphis is home to giant statues of Ramses, as well as the Temples of Ptah and Apis. Journey to the necropolis at Sakkara with its many pyramids as well as the famous Step-Pyramid of Djoser. Afternoon for painting with Walt Bartman in this area.

## DAY 5: CAIRO

Your excursion begins with a visit to the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities. Continue with a visit to the Citadel of Salah El Din with your afternoon for painting in the area. Overnight in Cairo.

## DAY 6: LUXOR

Transfer to airport for your flight to Luxor with the balance of your day at your leisure before included dinner and overnight.

## DAY 7: LUXOR

Tour of Luxor includes a morning visit to the Valley of the Kings, the twin statues of the Colossi of Memnon and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir el-Bahari. Afternoon to paint with Walt Bartman. Overnight in Luxor.

## DAY 8: LUXOR

Free day for painting - destinations to be determined by Walt Bartman. Included dinner and overnight.

## DAY 9: LUXOR

Morning excursion to the Temple of Luxor on the East Bank of the Nile, boasting many gigantic statues and chapels built by King Tut and Alexander the Great. Afternoon painting with Walt Bartman.

## DAY 10: LUXOR

Enjoy a free day for shopping, exploring or painting. Final overnight in Luxor.

## DAY 11: CAIRO

Board your flight to return to Cairo for a free day. Time to shop for souvenirs and explore before included Farewell Dinner.

Return flight.
