DAY 1:
Departure Flight.

DAY 2: VENICE
Arrive in Italy, and meet your Teach by Travel tour manager. The charm of Venice is yours today on your guided walking tour. See the Bridge of Sighs, Plaza San Marco, the Grand Canal, St. Mark's Basilica and the Palace of the Doges. Stroll through the tiny winding alleys, and watch the gondolas paddle down the canals. Free time for the excellent shopping Venice offers. Dinner and overnight in Venice.

DAY 3: VENICE, PADUA
Morning excursion to Padua, where Dante and Copernicus studied. The town center still evokes the days when the city and its university flourished in the late Middle Ages and the Renais-

sance, as a center of learning and art. Included entrance to Cappella degli Scrovegni. See the recently renovated cycle of vibrant frescoes by Giotto that revolutionized 14th-century painting and is considered among the most important early Renaissance art. Also see the eight-domed Basilica of Sant'Antonio di Padova, whose statue by Donatello stands in the piazza before it. Return to Venice for dinner and overnight.

DAY 4: VENICE - TUSCANY
Depart Venice and transfer to Florence to enjoy your guided tour of the world famous Uffizi Museum. Time to explore before dinner and overnight.

DAY 5: FLORENCE
Sights of Florence this morning on your guided city sightseeing

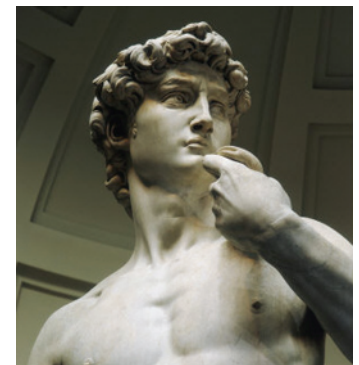
tour, including the Duomo, and the Doors of Paradise. No visit to Florence would be complete without entrance to the Accademia to see the world-famous David. Afternoon free to shop along the Ponte Vecchio.

DAY 6: TUSCANY-ROME
Morning transfer to Rome. Arrive with time to relax or explore on your own. You may want to walk to the Spanish Steps and observe the lively scene before dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 7: ROME
Guided city sightseeing tour of Rome, including the Vatican Museum and Sistine Chapel. Free time to window shop along the Via Veneto or visit the Baths of Caracalla. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 8: ROME
Guided tour of Ancient Rome this morning. See the Roman Forum, the Colosseum, Circus Maximus and more. Don't forget to toss a coin in the Trevi Fountain to ensure your return to Rome!
